There is an emergency medical waste with infectious risk, due to the global pandemic of the Covid-19 Virus.

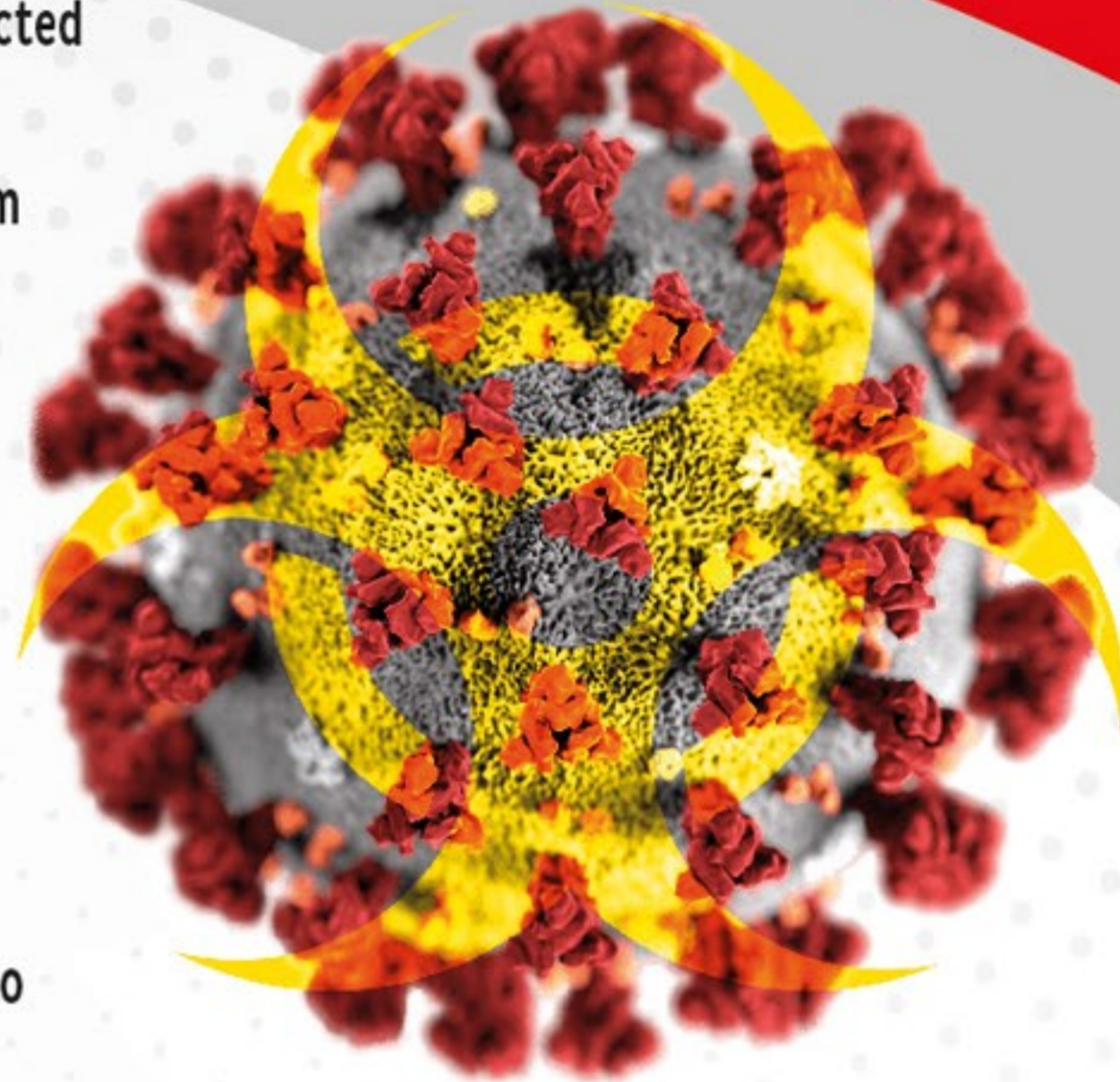
